Pope Leo XIV's Intention for July - For formation in discernment:

"Let us pray that we might again learn how to discern, to know how to choose paths of life, and reject everything that leads us away from Christ and the Gospel."

Reek Sunday 2025: This year's Reek Sunday falls on 27th July and the theme for 2025 is 'Christian Hope'. The late Pope Francis designated 2025 as a universal 'Jubilee Year of Hope' and, for this year, Croagh Patrick, Lough Derg and Knock have been identified by the Irish Bishops as national pilgrimage sites. These three well-known Irish sanctuaries have offered hope to pilgrims over generations and people can now obtain a 'Pilgrim Passport' for stamping when undertaking a pilgrimage to the three shrines during Jubilee Year 2025. Once all three pilgrimage sites are visited, a pilgrim is eligible to receive a special commemorative Jubilee Year medal. This annual pilgrimage will continue the 1,600-year-old tradition of people scaling Croagh Patrick to gather as a community of faith, to pray and participate in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Sacrament of the Eucharist at the summit.
