In Loving Memory of Father Jim Moore:



It is with profound sadness and a deep sense of loss that our Parish community learns of the passing of Father Jim Moore at the age of 59. Though his time ministering directly in our Parish was brief – serving us for two years immediately following his Ordination on 18th June 1995 – the impact of his ministry has spanned decades.

As a newly ordained priest, Fr. Jim brought a vibrant faith, energy, and a generous heart to our Parish. He was quickly loved in this place, and he remains very fondly remembered by all who had the privilege of crossing his path during those early years of his priesthood. He taught us, comforted us, and celebrated with us, leaving behind great memories and many stories to be told.

Fr. Jim's early days here were just the beginning of a lifetime defined by service. His deep care for both Parish life and the wider diocese was well known. He walked alongside countless families through their moments of greatest joy and deepest trial, always carrying the light of the Gospel with humility and grace. Leaving us far too young,

his absence will be felt acutely across the entire Diocese of Clogher, especially in Irvinestown, Enniskillen, Fintona and Clones where he ministered.

We extend our heartfelt prayers and deepest condolences to his loving family who mourn this immense loss. We hold in our hearts his mother, Winnie, and his siblings, Ethena, Marina, Niamh, Barry and Christopher. May they find comfort in their treasured memories and in the knowledge of how deeply Fr. Jim was cherished by the people he served.

Grant unto him eternal rest, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him. May his soul rest in peace.

- **First Holy Communion** - Saturday 15th May 2027

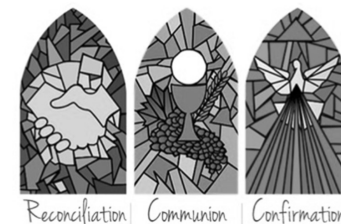
